



Conduct and Dress Agreement

While participating in the Motherhood Tea and Children's Fashion Show, those involved will not only represent Children of the World, but also the many sponsors and supporters of the event.

A key expectation for this fundraiser is that all those participating / attending, youth and adult alike, have a positive experience and desire to see the program grow and succeed year after year. For this expectation to be met there must be cooperation between the event organizers, participants & their parents.

- Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Children under the age of 14 must attend the event with an adult.
- Conduct / language deemed lewd or inappropriate will not be tolerated.
- Children of the World will not be responsible for any personal belongings left unattended.

- There is very limited space available for participants to change clothes / prepare for the show.
- All participants must at minimum arrive with hair and makeup ready.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring the fashion show attire is returned to a COTW representative before leaving the facility.
- Young Ladies must have appropriate length garments, fingertip or longer, no midriff visible, and no plunging back or neckline. We encourage the opportunity for self-expression. However, please keep in mind that more modest styles are appropriate for this event.
